Basilica Notre Dame

City Museum, Gia Long Palace
Bảo Tàng Thành Phố
In the center of the city, close to the Reunification Palace and the Palace of Justice, another major construction of the colonial period, the former Gia Long palace that now houses the town museum. Built in 1900 it features the style of Napoleon III, showing the strength (fortress), utility (utilitas) and sustainability (venustas). Initial plans were modeled on the colonnades of Louvre Claude Perrault. Today you will find an interesting collection about trade and craftsmen of the area of Saigon and Gia Dinh. ... Feel free to have a drink and admire the collection of old cars collections.

Hotel Caravelle

Hotel Continental

Many personalities and reporters had stayed there: French Prime Minister André Malraux, French President Jacques Chirac, Lucien Bodin and Jean Lartigue ... Move particularly, Graham Greene, host of the chamber 214, had written "A Quiet American". Please, have a coffee ...
